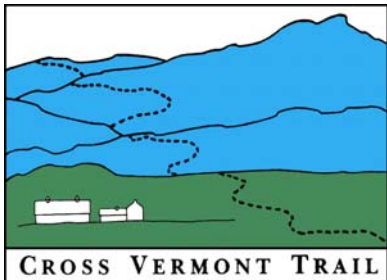


Students!
